OUTLINE OF SPECIAL H CASES

A In a general request for volunteers [redacted] volunteered for H experimentation and were originally tested on 21 May 1951. Both girls were, at this time, nineteen years of age.

A On 9 January 1952, in a group of volunteers, [redacted] was initially tested in the H techniques along with a group of volunteers.

A [redacted] at this time, was twenty years of age.

In each instance, all volunteers on the initial contact were given a brief discussion of H, were given a very general picture of Security's interest in the work and were given a very pointed lecture on the necessary security essential to these operations.

In each instance, after the above explanations had been made, all subjects were tested in the following manner:

- A. Falling back test.
- B. Hand and arm levitation test.
- C. General relaxation procedure with explanation.

A It should be noted that [redacted] in their initial tests, responded successfully to the falling back and levitation tests but on the relaxation or sleep induction tests were not overly successful. However,
